




Jubilee USA: Who We Are



Who are we?

Jubilee USA Network is a bipartisan, non-profit alliance of more than 75 US organizations and 550 faith communities working with 50 Jubilee global partners. Our mission is to build an inclusive global economy that benefits the most vulnerable and leaves no one behind. We have won critical global financial reforms and more than \$130 billion in debt relief for the world's poorest people.

What We Do:

In short, we work to change the policies that drive extreme poverty and inequality around the globe. At the White House, Congress, G7, United Nations, World Bank and International Monetary Fund, we advance common sense, responsible reforms to the international financial system that protect people living in poverty. We support expanded debt cancellation, rules for responsible lending and borrowing, an international bankruptcy process, international financial institution reform and

structures to protect vulnerable communities from predatory behavior.

What Makes Us Unique?

Our voice, our impact and our coalition.

Jubilee USA speaks with a unique voice. In the midst of partisan gridlock in Washington, we lift up issues that speak to shared values and unite Republicans, Democrats and people of all faiths to end global poverty. Jubilee brings the faith voice to the halls of power, representing and working alongside a broad coalition of religious groups to influence policymakers in Washington and around the world. That voice is powerful: in 2015, we won \$1.3 billion in debt relief in West Africa, Chad and the Caribbean and our work featured in 100,000 news stories around the world, including outlets like the *Wall Street Journal*, *New York Times* and *Washington Post*.

Jubilee wins major victories that benefit millions of the world's poorest people. \$130 billion in debt relief has translated into real change in people's lives. Our efforts helped send more than 52 million kids in Africa to school and provided clean water to millions more. Debt relief reduced infant mortality rates in countries across the world, saving lives from Latin America to Africa. On our budget, the \$1.3 billion in debt relief we won in 2015 translates to \$260,000 in new resources for the vulnerable for every \$100 donation we received.

Congressional Quarterly says our work represents some of the last remaining bi-partisan efforts left in Washington. We represent a broad spectrum of religious and political perspectives. Our steering committee includes American Jewish World Service, the leadership of Catholic religious orders and the national Episcopal, Lutheran, Methodist, Presbyterian, United Church of Christ, Unitarian and Quaker churches.
