We link ourselves with our brothers and sisters in the world's poorest countries.

This year, our theme is "Let there be Light" as we work to win transparency in the global financial system.

Specifically, we'll be focusing our efforts on two areas:

- 1. Launching a global campaign for increased transparency at the International Monetary Fund.
- 2. Promoting transparency in our financial system by encouraging policy makers to make it more difficult to form secret, anonymous "shell companies" that facilitate crime and corruption and drain billions of dollars from the world's poorest countries.

Through prayer and action your congregation can use our privilege of living in the world's most powerful democracy to raise up the voices of the most vulnerable through your advocacy efforts.
