ARTICLES OF INCORPRORATION OF JUBILEE USA NETWORK

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the NON-PROFIT CORPORATION ACT (D.C. Code, 2001 edition, Title 29, Chapter 3), adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Jubilee USA Network.

SECOND: The period of its duration is from the date of the approval of these Articles of Incorporation until the Jubilee USA Network determines that the purposes for which the corporation has been organized are completed.

THIRD: Its principle purposes for which the corporation is organized are to foster and sponsor educational development on issues pertaining to international development and debt.

FOURTH: (1) The corporation shall have members. (2) The members will be divided into the following classes, those that are member organizations of the Network Council, and other individual members that choose to share work with the corporation and are supporters. (3) Members of the Network Council will have the right to vote. They will be the primary body of the corporation. The individual members that choose to share work will not have the right to vote unless they form a local Jubilee chapter to have representation at the Network Council.

FIFTH: Members of the Network Council will elect the board of directors of the corporation, known as the Coordinating Committee, at Network Council meetings. The primary responsibility for the direction and management of the affairs of the Jubilee USA Network and the disposal of its property and funds shall be vested in the Coordinating Committee. This Coordinating Committee will be made up of between 10 and 15 members of the Network Council. A member of the Network Council can be nominated by any other member to become a candidate. The Network Council will vote to elect the members of the Coordinating Committee in order for the number of directors to be between 10 and 15. These elections can only take place at Network Council meetings.

SIXTH: (1) The regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation will be in the hands of the staff of the corporation and the members of the Coordinating Committee, under the supervision of the Network Council (2) The members of the Network Council must approve by majority vote any decision to dissolve or liquidate the corporation. All remaining assets of the corporation shall be distributed equally among the members of the Network Council.

SEVENTH: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 222 East Capitol Street, NE, Washington DC 20003. The name of the initial registered agent is Neil Watkins, 1809 Monroe St., NW, Washington, DC, 20010.
